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# Bibliometrics / Scientometrics

- Bibliographic databases
- Development of knowledge fields
- e.g.: **Actors** (authors, institutions)  
Connections  
-> Scientific networks and their development

**clear and easy**

# vs. Themes/Topics

- common expression for:
  - ‘term’ or ‘word’
  - ‘concept’
- substantive component  
(cognitive structure, scientific context)
  - > **different** to actors  
**not** clear and easy!
  - term-level (e.g. title words)
    - > quite diffuse contents
  - general concepts
    - > too rough classifications

# Concepts

- Satija 2004 (following Ingetraut Dahlberg 1974: "A unit of thought (...) constituted through abstraction on the basis of properties common to a set of objects; a mental image formed by generalization. It is generally regarded as the product of a 'system of orderly thinking'...". (an idea behind certain words, including other words and their relation)).
- Content analysis: several terms (variants , partial aspects of the examined concept)

# Example

Herfurth et al. 2003:

- "elderly employees"
- literature search
- 4 German databases

-> current research trends

# Topics

- Frequent :  
Descriptors “*older employed person*” like  
“*older labourer*” and “*elderly employee*” (and  
language variants) -> query formulation
- More general semantic subject areas:  
formal content analysis of the descriptors  
-> rough, fuzzy concepts

Descriptors: denominations that are chosen from an obligatory term list


No. <= 2 % under the percentage of the total period 1985-2000

No. < 2 % above or equal the percentage of the total period 1985-2000

No. > 2 % above the percentage of the total period 1985-2000

-> extent of ups and downs

# Multidimensional Space (2 axes)



-> Structural similarity by context  
not by co-occurrence

Example: Nutrition Science  
Correspondence Analysis

# Connections

- Thematic network
- **Relations between the topics**
- Indirect semantic proximities
- Bivariate strengths of relations  
(Jaccard coefficient)

The Jaccard contingency coefficient varies from 0 (no relation) to 1 (maximum connection).

Does not indicate which of the both terms has a higher frequency.

Only coefficients over 0.2 were accepted.


Minimum frequency of the relations was 5 and only the most frequent 80 descriptors were chosen.

# Topic Graphs

Concept **frequencies** together with the **relations**

- CONCEPT to CONCEPTS                    C1 – C2
- CONCEPTS to descriptors                C1 – d1
- descriptors to descriptors              d1 – d2

# Semantic net (1985-2000)



-> direct and indirect connections

->2 levels

# Main Topics 1985-2000

- Main concepts (in MAJOR notation) are the strongest
  - descriptor terms vary
  - used differently in the 4 databases
- 2 Central concept complexes:
  - 1. around the larger subject area **WORK** and
  - 2. a smaller one around the subject area **GENDER** being in loose connection with each other by **demography**.
- **WORK** is in connection to *EARLY RETIREMENT*, *PENSION*, *RETIREMENT*, *OLD PEOPLE* (resp. *elderly employee and old person*) and to *STATE*, which are less connected between each other

# Temporal Development

- **Stability** by large **concepts**

and

- **Dynamics** by constituting **descriptors**




Fig. 1: Semantic net in the time period 1985-1988

# 1989-1992




Fig. 2: Semantic net in the time period 1989-1992

# 1993-1996




Fig. 3: Semantic net in the time period 1993-1996

# 1997-2000




Fig. 4: Semantic net in the time period 1997-2000

# Periodical Development

## Consistency:

- *STATE* protection a central theme (in relation to *SOCIAL SITUATION*)
- *part-time work* always present at the *WORKING HOURS* models
  - initially *flexibility* and *reducing of working hours*
  - finally *partial retirement*

## Upcomming themes:

- 1983: methodological and theoretical treatment (*SCIENCE*) – in connection with the area 'elderly employees'
- 1989: *LEGAL* aspects get more concrete
- 1989: *HEALTH* aspects
- 1993: *EAST* (- west) aspects, but declining
- 1997: *BUSINESS*
- 1997: *GENDER* , but declining

## Indirect connections:

- *EDUCATION* only in indirect connection with the area 'elderly employees' - in all time periods

## Isolated themes (not connected with the area 'elderly employees'):

- *PRIVACY* and *EUROPE* in all time periods

# Summary

- **Bibliometric studies:**  
thematic questions might lead to quite random, chaotic results (single terms)
- multivariate reduction (cluster analysis, correspondence analysis):
  - Cluster of individual terms does not reveal the theoretical concepts lying behind them
  - Spatial constellation does not correspond with their individual co-occurrence.
- Only theoretical constructs (ex ante or ex post):  
only rough with no special empirical meaning
- **Thematic network analysis: *context-specific words and broader concepts***
  - > - Concepts get concrete interpretation and vice versa,
    - Special descriptors are arranged more aptly.
    - Temporal consistency of the mapping of the concepts,  
while the keywords can vary considerably dependent on time.
